

Family Childcare Home Licensing Regulations on Large Capacity of 14 Children

You may care for:



Twelve Children:

Four infants and eight children who are at least 2 years of age or; Three infants and nine children who are at least 2 years of age or; Two infants and ten children who are at least 2 years of age or; One infant and eleven children who are at least 2 years of age or; Twelve children who are at least 2 years of age or;



Option to care for fourteen children:

Three infants & eleven children who are over the age of 2. Two children must be enrolled in and attending school and one of these children must be at least six years old or;

Two infants & twelve children who are over the age of 2. Two children must be enrolled in and attending school and one of these children must be at least six years old or;

One infant & thirteen children who are over the age of 2. Two children must be enrolled in and attending school and one of these children must be at least six years old or;

Fourteen children who are over two years of age. Two children must be enrolled in and attending school. One of these children must be at least six years of age.

Conditions for optional license of 14:

- One child is enrolled in and attending Kindergarten or above. The second child must be 6 years old or older
- You must have landlord consent
- Parents must acknowledge receipt of the "Parent Notification of Additional Children in Care" notice.
- No more than three infants are cared for during any time when there are more than 12 children present.

Remember: Once you exceed the capacity of a Small FCCH license you must have an assistant present.
